All applicants must be 15 years or older.

IN ORDER OF APPEARANCE:

Bruce:

- 15/16 years old
- Year 11
- Can be played by a male or female.
- 3 speaking scenes, with other ensemble work including dances.

Best friends with Brian, they can often be seen riding their bicycles around school grounds making fun of and teasing Jamie, Michelle and Kim. While they are the school thugs, it doesn't take a lot for them to run away with their tails between their legs.

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Nicole:

- 16/17 years old
- Year 12
- 2 speaking scenes, with other ensemble work including dances.

Nicole is a goodie two shoes, she cares strongly about world events. Nicole is always trying to get Jamie, Michelle and Kim involved in her next cause, which leads to a lot of disappointment for Nicole when they don't take it as seriously or know what she is talking about. Nicole is secretly in love with Mr Hotschilt, this is implied in a voice over at the end of the play.

Mr Hotschilt:

- Student Teacher
- early 20's
- 1 speaking scene, with other ensemble work including dances.

Mr Hotschilt is the current student teacher at the school. A lot of the girls in the school have a crush on him, especially Michelle and Kim. Unbeknownst to him many of the girls have nicknamed him Mr Hotshit. Mr Hotschilt is having a secret affair with Nicole, this is implied in a voice over at the end of the play.

Katrina:

- 13/14 years old
- Year 8
- 1 speaking scene, with other ensemble work including dancing.

Katrina is in year 8 and is currently the night manager of Parker Street Video store. Which she takes very seriously. She loves movies and quotes them often. If you pop into the video store in the evenings you can often see her bossing Dwyane around, who is at least 3 years older than her. She has worked at Parker Street Video Store 5 months longer than Dwyane, making her the senior night manager.

Kayla:

- 16/17 years old
- Year 12
- 1 speaking scene, with other ensemble work including dancing.

Kayla is in year 12 and is President of the Seniors Culture Committee, she has spent months organising the Harvest Festival's Student Ball. Kayla gets expelled for growing and bringing a marijuana plant to school, this is implied in a voice over at the end of the play.

Dylan McMillan:

- 16/17 years old
